

# Garbage Separation and Disposal Guide

- "Plastic Containers/Packaging" and some other garbage are manually sorted.  
Do not put plastic bags with garbage inside into designated garbage bags.
- You can take out up to 3 bags of garbage at once.

## Burnable Garbage

Kitchen garbage  
Non-recyclable paper waste,  
used cloth, grass or trees etc



Designated garbage bag (Green) (45 l, 30 l, 15 l)

## Recyclable Waste

### Used Paper/Clothing

- Newspaper/Advertising flyers
- Magazines/Miscellaneous paper waste
- Corrugated cardboard and the like
- Paper beverage cartons
- Used clothes



Please separate them into 5 types and bundle them tight with strings.

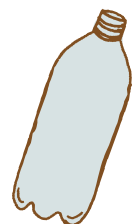
- Used paper is acceptable if it's raining.
- Please keep used clothes until the next collection day if it's raining

- × Non-recyclable items such as clothes with dirt or damage, yarn products, underwear, socks and the like ⇒ "Burnable Garbage"
- × Used cloth such as towels and shirts ⇒ "Burnable Garbage"

※In case you have difficulty bundling small pieces of paper, please put them into a paper bag or insert them between pages of magazines and the like and then bundle it crosswise with strings.

### Plastic Bottles

Plastic bottles with  
Logo for PET  
for soft drinks, designated seasonings,  
alcoholic beverages and the like



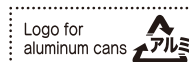
Transparent bag (Semi-transparent bag is acceptable)

- Empty the bottles and rinse inside with water.

- × Peeled-off labels and stickers with Paper-made ones ⇒ "Burnable Garbage"
- × Caps (must be removed) ⇒ "Plastic Containers/Packaging"

### Glass Bottles and Cans

Glass bottles/jars, aluminum/  
steel cans mainly used  
for food or drinks



Transparent bag (Semi-transparent bag is acceptable)

- Put "glass bottles" and "cans" in the same bag together.
- Empty the bottles, jars or cans and rinse inside with water.

- × Broken glass waste, heat resistant glass, glass bottles or cans for chemicals, cans for coating materials and spray cans ⇒ "Hazardous Materials"

※Please return empty sake bottles and beer bottles back to the shop where the item was purchased whenever possible for disposal.

### Plastic Containers/packaging

Plastic-made containers or  
packaging



Designated garbage bag (Yellow) (45 l, 30 l, 15 l)

- Empty the bottles or trays, rinse them with water.

- × Containers for home chemicals (Detergents with warning "Do not mix, Hazardous", herbicides, pesticides etc) ⇒ "Hazardous Materials"
- × Containers for agricultural chemicals or poisonous substances ⇒ Not accepted

### Other Plastic

Pure/hard plastic-made products or mostly plastic-made products  
with partial paper or cloth contents.

(Notes) The basics for recycling are separation and quality. Please remove dirt or filth the best you can.

## Non-Burnable Garbage

Metal, complex products containing  
plastic or metal etc.



Designated garbage bag (Blue) (45 l, 30 l, 15 l)

- × Batteries (must be removed) for small home appliances and the like ⇒ "Hazardous Materials"
- × Chargeable batteries for small home appliances and the like are not accepted. Please take them to stores which collect them.

Small home appliances, clocks,  
umbrellas (bundle up to 5 with  
strings), cookware etc

## Hazardous Materials

Items which can be harmful for collection or sort work

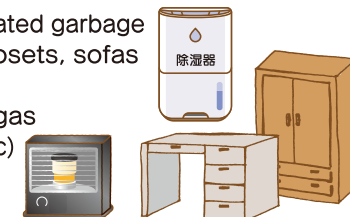
- Batteries (Chargeable batteries are not accepted), blades, spray cans, video tapes, glass waste, ceramics, bags for gardening fertilizers etc
- Waste fluorescent lamps or bulbs, ash (Please put it in an individual bag.)
- Containers for home chemicals (Detergents with warning "Do not mix. Hazardous", herbicides, pesticides etc)
- Home medical supplies (Injection needles are not accepted)



Transparency plastic bag (Semi-transparent bag is acceptable)  
※Must not be taken out in designated garbage bags.

## Large-Sized Waste

- Items which do not fit in designated garbage bags (45 l) Bicycles, beds, closets, sofas, laundry poles etc
- Products that may use freon gas (dehumidifier, cold air machine etc)
- Kerosene heaters (Fan heaters, stoves etc)



Please request door-to-door collection (Payment is required) or take them to Household Waste Reception Center (1 Rinkai-cho, Shunan City).

Procedures for Disposal (Either of ①~④)

- ① Request electric retail stores or authorized collection traders (Payment is required)
- ② Purchase Home Appliance Recycling Tickets at a post office ⇒ Take them to designated collection sites individually
- ③ Purchase Home Appliance Recycling Tickets at a post office ⇒ Request door-to-door collection to Recycling Promotion Division (Payment is required)
- ④ Request to a private company with which the city has a partnership agreement (Paid)

## Personal Computers

Home Collection Service Renet Japan Recycle, Inc. which has signed an agreement with the city, will collect your computer, if needed.

- Peripheral devices such as printers, scanners, etc., and other small appliances can be collected at the same time.
- The total of the box's three dimensions (length, width, height) should be no more than 140cm, and the weight should be no more than 20kg.

Waste Collection Boxes Collection takes place at five Small Home Appliance collection boxes located throughout the city.

- Small home appliances (computers, mobile phones, digital cameras, etc.) that fit in the 40cm x 20cm collection slot are accepted. Larger sized waste is not accepted at these collection boxes.
- Collection boxes are located at the City Hall Recycling Promotion Division, Recycle Plaza Pegasus Kanyokan, and the general branch offices in Shin-Nanyo, Kumage, and Kano.



Collection by manufacturer When possible, please request collection from the manufacturer.

- If your computer does not have the recycle mark shown, recycling fees, etc. will apply at the time of disposal.
- For self-made computers or computers whose manufacturer is unknown, please contact the PC3R Promotion Association (☎03-5282-7685; <https://www.pc3r.jp/>) and request collection.

## Items Which are Not Accepted

Tires, motorbikes, car batteries, fire-extinguishers,  
farm implements, agricultural chemicals, coating  
materials, chargeable batteries, injection needles etc
